

WEBSITE TERMS OF USE

CARVALHO, SICA, MUSZKAT, VIDIGAL E CARNEIRO SOCIEDADE DE ADVOGADOS

This Terms of Use of the website ("Terms of Use") is intended to establish the guidelines relating to the use of the website "www.csmv.com.br" ("Website") by all those who access it ("User" or "Users").

By browsing the Website, Users express their agreement with the conditions set forth in these Terms of Use. The use of the Website is also conditioned upon acceptance of other terms and policies associated with the Website, such as the Privacy and Data Protection Policy and the Cookie Policy, which are hereby incorporated by reference. Therefore, Users must carefully read such terms and policies, ensure they have understood them, be aware of all conditions established in these Terms of Use, and commit to complying with them.

If you do not agree with the conditions below or with any of the conditions set forth in our Privacy and Data Protection Policy, available at ("Privacy Policy"), or in our Cookie Policy, available at ("Cookie Policy"), the User must immediately cease their use of the Website.

These Terms of Use, together with the Privacy Policy and the Cookie Policy, constitute the entire and binding agreement between the User and Carvalho, Sica, Muszkat, Vidigal e Carneiro Sociedade de Advogados, a law firm enrolled with the CNPJ/MF under No. 11.367.716/0001-48, with registered office at Avenida Brigadeiro Faria Lima, No. 1461, Torre Sul, suites 91/94, Jardim Paulistano, in the City of São Paulo, State of São Paulo, ZIP Code 01452-002 ("CSMV" or "Firm"), with respect to the use of the Website.

1. Website Information and Content

The Website is controlled and operated by CSMV. In this regard, the Website will make available various information relating to the Firm's activities and its legal practices, including newsletters and articles written by the Firm's legal team ("Content").

The Content is made available for informational purposes only regarding legal topics, as well as the Firm and its members, and shall not be used or interpreted by the User, under any circumstances, as legal opinions or legal guidance, nor as part of an attorney/client relationship, which shall only be established through direct contact between clients and CSMV's attorneys and upon execution of a legal services agreement.

CSMV may, at any time and at its sole discretion, make changes to the Website's settings without prior notice to Users.

2. Access to the Website

Users are not required to register or provide any personal data to access the information on the Website.

Should the User choose to contact CSMV through the "Contact" tool available on the Website, or through any email address disclosed on the Website or in any of our policies, the User shall bear sole and exclusive responsibility for the accuracy of any information and personal data provided.

Users who intend to register in our database for the purpose of participating in selection processes for open positions at CSMV will have their data collected through the registration form and other communication channels available on the Website, and such data will be forwarded to our administrative department so that it may be reviewed by members of the Firm.

In any case of data sharing by the User, such data will be processed in accordance with the Privacy Policy.

3. Restrictions on the Use of the Website by the User

By using the Website, the User agrees to:

- i. Not copy, reproduce, reverse engineer, derive source code, modify, disassemble, decompile, or create works based on the Website, in whole or in part;
- ii. Not use any information obtained through the use of the Website, which is the exclusive property of CSMV, with the intent to create similar products or services that replicate, in whole or in part, any of the legal services provided by CSMV;
- iii. Not infringe, alter, or remove, or attempt to infringe, alter, or remove, any trademark, logo, or element protected by CSMV's intellectual property rights related to the Website;
- iv. Not copy, reproduce, disseminate, or transmit in an automated and/or systematic manner any content available through the Website;
- v. Not collect or attempt to collect any data or information from other Users of the Website;
- vi. Not breach, or attempt to breach, any security measure employed by CSMV on the Website, nor access, or attempt to access, any data, information, network, or server

managed or used by CSMV whose access does not arise from the regular use of the Website;

- vii. Not interfere with the Website in a manner that exceeds its regular use, including, without limitation, hacking the Website or any server managed or used by CSMV, overloading or attempting to overload the Website, or sending malware or spam to any email address provided by CSMV or through the "Contact" tool available on the Website.

In the event of a breach of these Terms of Use, CSMV may, at its sole discretion, block the User's access to the Website, temporarily or permanently, without prejudice to pursuing all available legal remedies for liability arising from any damages caused to CSMV or any third party as a result of such breach.

4. Intellectual Property

All Website Content, including articles, posts, databases, trademarks, texts, graphics, icons, designs, colors, layout, services, information, materials, instruments, page organization, drawings, and other elements, are protected by intellectual property legislation and are the exclusive property of or licensed to CSMV. Their reproduction and/or use by third parties is strictly prohibited without the prior express written consent of CSMV and without proper attribution of the source, under penalty of all applicable legal measures.

5. Third-Party Websites and Their Content

The Website may contain links to third-party websites or applications, such as news outlets and social media profiles, for the convenience of its Users. Users expressly agree and acknowledge that CSMV is not responsible for the content, goods, and services made available on or through such third-party websites or applications.

6. Limitation of Liability

CSMV shall not be liable, under any circumstances, to any person for any type of loss, damage, cost, or expense resulting from any inaccuracy, error, omission, or alteration in the information provided on the Website or in these Terms of Use, nor for any delays or interruptions related to the Content published through the Website.

Furthermore, CSMV shall not, under any circumstances, be held liable for the quality of the internet connection of Users' devices, for the availability or unavailability of internet access services provided by third parties, for the inability to use any information or third-party services arising from the technical incompatibility of Users' devices, or for any breach of

privacy or data security of Users during the connection of their devices to the internet through third-party services.

CSMV is constantly updating the Website in order to make new Content available, implement new features, or strengthen information security measures, and may, at any time and at its sole discretion, add or remove features, change or adjust the Website's layout, as well as review, modify, and/or remove any previously available content, without such actions constituting any breach of these Terms of Use or giving rise to any right to compensation on the part of the User.

Should CSMV, or any of its partners and/or employees, be subject to legal proceedings due to a User's use of the Website in violation of these Terms of Use or any applicable law, such User shall be fully liable for such violation and shall be responsible for indemnifying the defendant(s) should they be ordered to pay compensation as a result of acts carried out in breach of these Terms of Use or any applicable law.

The exclusions and limitations of liability set forth in this section shall apply to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law.

7. General Provisions

No omission, waiver, concession, or tolerance by CSMV in connection with the exercise of the rights granted under these Terms of Use shall constitute a waiver of such rights. Should any provision of these Terms of Use be declared null or unenforceable, such nullity or unenforceability shall not affect any other provisions of these Terms of Use, which shall remain in full force and effect.

These Terms of Use may be updated by CSMV at any time by simply making a new version available on the Website. The updated version of the Terms of Use shall come into effect 5 (five) days after being made available on the Website. After this period, should the User continue accessing the Website or using its features, the User represents and warrants having read and agreed to the new version of the Terms of Use.

These Terms of Use are governed by Brazilian law. Any disputes arising from the provisions of these Terms of Use shall be settled before the courts of the Judicial District of São Paulo, State of São Paulo, with express waiver of any other jurisdiction, however privileged it may be or become.
